Not only have we met many mission-minded friends who support us both financially and prayerfully, God opened doors to ensure that the growing physical and spiritual needs of Kajiado Children's Home were met. We appreciate all the donors who donated towards these important goals. Below is a summary of our 2024 achievements. We cannot do this work without you!

Improved Agricultural program at Kajiado Children's Home.

-- To make room for the new primary school, the farm, greenhouses and gardens were relocated, providing an opportunity to update structures and expand farm/animal projects and enhance processes at KCH. A deep water well and solar panels were also added to this area of the campus.

Improved Educational program at Valley School of Excellence.

-- The new primary school now offers exceptional programming and resources such as a library, computer lab and music/ art/ agricultural programs. Due to the talented teachers hired, our students final grades increased over 2023 scores in the government schools where little resources were available. New School Bus transportation is now available for local village children attending the new school.

-- The Early Child Development program was also expanded to include a two-year old class. Accredited teachers lead the pre-K and Kindergarten classes to prepare the students for transition into primary school.

-- The Bright Horizons program, focusing on older KCH student readiness for life after high school, was also expanded offering workshops in career research and college enrollment. Students not eligible for college are offered vocational training to gain skills to support themselves as young adults.

We cannot do this without you. It is your compassion and support that provides these children hope... for food, shelter, loving care... for education, medical care, and most importantly, for spiritual nourishment. Thank you.

2024-2025 Capital project plans:

- 1) **2024's Phase One Capital** for a new primary school began with planning in 2019, fundraising in 2020 and construction beginning in Dec 2023. It was an amazing experience to see this goal met. Thanks be to God! We appreciate all of the support of our wonderful donors and church partners. The new school, equipped with great resources and the latest technology will better prepare our students for success.
- 2) **2025 Phase Two** (beginning construction in January) will include a new kitchen/dining hall and junior high school to accommodate the larger student population.
- 3) **Other projects completed on campus** to provide resources for Kajiado Children's Home and Valley School of Excellence included farm/animal keeping project expansion, a new deep water well with solar panels, underground water storage tank, school buses to transport neighboring village students, and more. Text books were provided for all students at KVSE; classroom monitors for all classes; books for library; fully functional computer lab with internet available across campus.
- 4) **2026 educational program expansions** will include musical instruments, additional art program resources, and physical education programming including a new soccer field. Other future projects planned include solar panels for the dorms, and a secondary school targeted for 2030 to be built off campus.

We appreciate the continued support of our donors and volunteers to help provide physical and spiritual nourishment in a safe environment. This makes an incredible impact in the lives of these children. Without your prayers and financial support, these children would face poverty and disease in their lives. Thank you.
